### II. Consent Calendar

On a motion by Director Michael Recupero, which was seconded by Director Nancy Gardner, the minutes of the March 16, 2017, Board of Directors meeting (with abstentions from those who were not present at the meeting), 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2017 Investment Report, May 31, 2017 Financial Report, Wildland Report, Committee Reports, and Strategic Plan Update were approved unanimously.

### III. Governance

<u>Election of At-Large Public Alternate (Recreation)</u>.—President LaMar called directors' attention to the information in the Board packet introducing Hallie Jones, Executive Director of the Laguna Canyon Foundation, a candidate for the At-Large Public Alternate for Recreation. The President called for a motion and discussion.

On a motion by Director Stacy Blackwood, which was seconded by Director Gardner, the appointment of Hallie Jones to a two-year term as At-Large Public Alternate for Recreation was approved unanimously.

Addition of Viejo Property (Portola South) to the NCCP/HCP Reserve of the Central and Coastal Subregion of Orange County.—Executive Director James Sulentich reported that ownership, management and endowment agreements among the Wildlife Agencies, Baldwin & Sons, and the Southwest Resource Management Association (SRMA) have been finalized for the Viejo Property (also known as Portola South). The stage is set for the approximately 100 acres to be added to the Reserve.

<u>Ex-Officio Board Membership: Southwest Resource Management Association.</u>—With the addition of the Viejo Property to the NCCP/HCP Reserve, the NCC Executive Committee discussed and recommends to the Board of Directors inviting the SRMA, the owner and manager of the property, to join the NCC Board as an Ex-Officio member. President LaMar called for a motion.

On a motion by Director Gardner, which was seconded by Director Kenneth Borngrebe, the recommendation to invite Southwest Resource Management Association to join the NCC Board of Directors as a permanent Ex-Offico member was approved unanimously.

## IV. Executive Director's Report

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To accommodate the annual Reserve field trip at the conclusion of the regular meeting, the executive director provided a brief introduction to the purpose and logistics associated with the tour.

President LaMar asked if Board members and other meeting attendees had any announcements or questions of the Board. No communication was offered.
